We specialize in offering fun, low stress programs in a group setting where people can spend time socializing, getting to know others, and reconnecting by being active outdoors. Our Women's Golf Academy, Girls Golf Days, and Family Golf Programs help unite friends and family together.

We embrace the life skills we learn from golf and present them within our programs. We know we don't always hit great shots or have great days, but golf teaches us coping skills to pick ourselves up and move forward. Golf teaches us to be brave and confident enough to be willing to get out there, make a swing, meet new people, and have the willingness to show up. These programs are designed not only to improve your golf, but to help you grow in everyday life.

GIRLS GOLF PROGRAM

This empowerment program teaches girls confidence, builds their self-esteem, works on their athletic abilities, and uses the game of golf to do that! Our team of PGA and LPGA instructors and coaches has demonstrated a recognized ability to create significant and sustained improvement with students, while showing a clear passion for their craft. Our team has over 100 years of combined experience, led by 3-time Wisconsin PGA Teacher of the Year, Travis Becker. Our services are open year round to Beloit Club members and the general public.

CLUB FITTING/TECHNOLOGY

The Ironworks Golf Academy is one of only two Premier Fitting Centers in the state. Premier Fitting Centers feature Titleist and TaylorMade partners who make club fitting the centerpiece of their daily selling activities. The centers are equipped with over 5,000 club combinations and utilize launch monitors to offer a high level of service for golfers who want an in-depth and thorough fitting experience.

Our studios are equipped with a wider selection of fitting tools, stateof-the-art technologies, and certified club fitters to offer a high level of service. To compliment Titleist and satisfy our clients, our fitting family offers Callaway, Ping, TaylorMade, and Mizuno, the other leaders in the golf club industry. These companies have represented the #1 driver, iron, wedge, putter, and golf ball on the world tours for years. BELOIT CLUB CADDIE PROGRAM

In 2017, the Beloit Club partnered with the Western Golf Association to offer caddies to our members and guests. In 1930, the Western Golf Association established the Chick Evans Scholarship for caddies, which is a full tuition and housing college scholarship. The average total value of an Evans Scholarship is \$80,000 per student. Currently, 910 students are enrolled at 18 leading universities, including University of Wisconsin-Madison, Marquette University, Northwestern, and University of Illinois. Since the first scholarship was awarded in 1930, more than 10,000 alumni have graduated from the program. Applications for the Evans Scholarship are accepted at the beginning of the senior year of high school. Applicants will be evaluated by the scholarship committee on the following criteria: strong caddie record, excellent academics, financial need, character, and leadership.

The Beloit Club enhances our golfers' experience by offering optional caddies, while providing an incredible opportunity for the local youth. Our goal is to educate our golfers on the benefit of utilizing caddies, setting the stage for a Beloit Club caddie to earn this wonderful scholarship. It will take hard work on the part of our staff to recruit and train caddies. Most importantly, it will take strong support from our members to utilize these caddies and encourage others to do so. Only with the support of our members will we be successful in reaching our goal of providing this great opportunity for some of our deserving local youth.

JUNIOR GOLF

The Beloit Club's Junior Golf Program provides the children of members an opportunity to learn from the best instructors in the state of Wisconsin and enjoy the game of golf in a FUN and safe environment. The Beloit Club offers two junior memberships and three memberfriendly programs for juniors ranging from ages 5-18.

PGA JUNIOR GOLF LEAGUE

The PGA Junior Golf League is a national program supported by the PGA of America. This program is a fun, social, and inclusive opportunity for boys and girls ages 13 and under to learn and enjoy the game in a low stress environment. Participants wear numbered jerseys and compete in a team format against other area golf facilities. Practices start in mid-May and continue into June and July with team matches.

In 2017, the Beloit-Janesville All-Star team, led by Travis Becker, captured first place in Wisconsin. In 2018, the Beloit Club was selected by the PGA of America to host one of 11 Regionals around the country. In 2019 and 2021, the Beloit-Janesville All-Star Team capped off another stellar season by finishing runner-up in Wisconsin.

SUPER TUESDAY PROGRAM

The Super Tuesday Program, for children ages 5-13, emphasizes having FUN at the golf course and learning some basic golf fundamentals, rules, and etiquette. The program is divided into two age groups (5-9 and 10-13).

PLAYER PERFORMANCE PROGRAM

The Player Performance Program is designed for juniors ranging in age from 14-18. This program is designed for the students to take their game to the next level. It focuses on the scoring game, course management, and routine development. This program is held on Tuesday mornings with instruction followed by nine holes of golf.



IRONWORKS GOLF LAB

The Ironworks Golf Lab, located in downtown Beloit, is the latest amenity available to our members. This state-of-the-art instructional and entertainment center is available year-round, no matter what the weather is outside.

ENTERTAINMENT/PARTIES

Ironworks Golf Lab offers two different types of simulators (HD and Visual Sports) that are rented by the hour for private golf lessons, a professional club fitting, practice times, golf competitions, or a round of golf with friends. With over 100 of the best courses in the world, including Pebble Beach and St. Andrews, they not only look real-they play real! Our Visual Sports simulators also offer 13 different sport games for intense competitors or pure fun!

Our two visual sports simulators allow all ages to play up to 13 different games and sports. The Golf Lab is also the perfect place for birthday parties, bachelor/bachelorette parties, corporate events, and vouth sports team outings (everyone loves zombie dodgeball).

INSTRUCTION

In addition to our simulators, we also have a full practice facility that is available to our Golf Academy students and features a short range hitting bay with turf-like golf mats that simulate golf course conditions and a 3,000-square-foot putting green with 2-inch, 3-inch, and regulation-sized cups to improve your accuracy and short game.

Other amenities include our putting studio featuring SAM PuttLab technology, our TPI studio, world-class club fitting, and custom club repair services.

TECHNOLOGY

At the Ironworks Golf Lab, we pride ourselves on utilizing the best technology the golf industry has to offer in order to efficiently and effectively help our students. Below are some of the technologies utilized by Ironworks Golf Academy instructors on a daily basis.

TrackMan 4: Allows our instructors to measure in real time what the club and ball are doing in three-dimensional space.

SAM PuttLab: Measures no fewer than 28 parameters of the putting stroke using ultrasound measurements.

TPI Studio: Used to find a way to allow each player to swing a golf club in the most efficient way possible, and can analyze how physical limitations can adversely affect the golf swing.

K-VEST: A golf-specific human motion learning system that allows you to see your swing, visualize proper movement patterns, measure full kinematic sequencing, and obtain perfect practice.

RECIPROCAL BENEFITS

We have added several great clubs around the state to our golfing reciprocal list. Pine Hills CC (Sheboygan), Nakoma CC (Madison), Racine CC, North Hills (Menomonee Falls), West Bend CC, Butte des Morts (Appleton), South Hills (Fond du Lac), and Greenwood Hills CC (Wausau) are all accessible by requesting tee times through the Beloit Club golf shop. The same \$50 fee applies. We strongly urge our golfing members to take advantage of these great opportunities that add so much value to vour membership. Benefits are also available at Janesville Country Club, Rockford Country Club, Forest Hills Country Club (Rockford), and Mauh-Nah-Tee-See Country Club (Rockford). All of these clubs can be played for \$50, including cart fee.

Payment must be made with cash or credit card at the time of service; charge backs to the Beloit Club are not permitted.

Dining options are available at Janesville CC, Rockford CC, Forest Hills CC, Mauh-Nah-Tee-See, the Madison Club, and the Wiscosnin Club. Dining reservations can be requested through the Beloit Club administrative office or concierge. We ask that you make these requests a minimum of 48 hours prior to your desired time. Making the request does not guarantee a reservation.

Finally, Blonhaven provides the region's premier outdoor hunting experience. Beloit Club members receive Blonhaven member pricing without paying annual dues. Reservations may be made by calling 608.290.8614. The Blonhaven season runs from late September through mid-April.

We encourage all our members to utilize these reciprocal benefits.

MEMBERSHIP REFERRALS

We always encourage our members to bring friends and family to their club. As a reminder, we offer the option to pay by cash or credit card, so you don't always have to put charges on your club account. In other words, your friends can take a turn buying! We feel that our facilities and friendly service impress our guests, but we always welcome more people through our doors. With that in mind, we offer a new member referral program as follows: If a current member refers or "sponsors" a new member, we will credit the current members' account \$50 for a Dining, Social and Sport, and \$100 for a Golf and Golf Plus membership. These credits will be recognized in the first quarter of the following year after the new member has re-joined. If the new member joined with pro-rated rates, the issuing credit would be pro-rated accordingly.

TRAVIS BECKER - DIRECTOR OF INSTRUCTION, IRONWORKS GOLF ACADEMY




Travis Becker, our Director of Instruction, joined the Beloit Club in 2016. Travis brings a wealth of experience and knowledge along with a dedicated following of students.

We are excited for Evan to continue to grow while broadening his experiences with our companies after having successfully worked in our Standard Tavern and banquet operations for the last two years.


ROBERTO GUTIERREZ – CHEF
